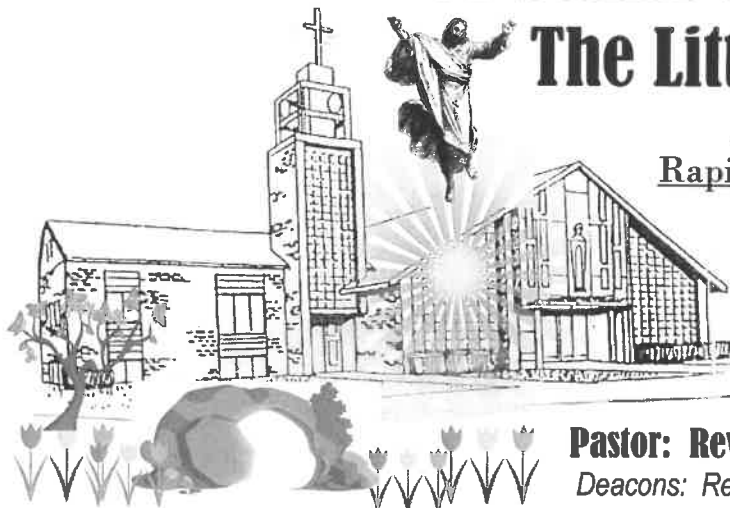

Honoring the Gift of Motherhood on Mother's Day
Happy Mother's Day to all mothers! Mother's Day is a day of celebration honoring the mother of the family, the gift of motherhood, maternal bonds, and the influence of mothers in society and culture. It was within that sacred space of our mother's womb that we were wonderfully made.

You formed my inmost being; you knit me in my mother's womb. I praise you, because I am wonderfully made; wonderful are your works! My very self you know. ~ Psalm 139: 13-14

Mothers are living, breathing, walking tabernacles of love!

They carry the sacred gift of life within them, nurturing their children to become the very men and women that God has called them to be.

When we hear the words at Mass, "this is My Body, given for you", let us always remember to pray for our mothers; we can connect the suffering that leads to new life in childbirth and raising children to the suffering of Jesus's Passion that gives us new life in His Resurrection.

Our mothers sacrificed their very bodies to form, protect, and nurture us, just as Christ sacrificed His very Body to form us into the family of God, to safeguard our souls, and nurture us with His Body and Blood in the Most Holy Eucharist. With these connections in mind, our mothers present for us a beautiful image of Christ in His love for us!

The Church needs the authentic and beautiful gift of motherhood, so let us pray for all women who are expectant mothers and all women who have chosen this beautiful path to holiness as their vocation!

But just as we have earthly mothers who are walking tabernacles of love, who carry the sacred gift of life within them, who nurture us to become the men and women God calls us to be, so too do we have spiritual mothers and a heavenly mother.

Just as we have earthly mothers and spiritual mothers, we also have a heavenly mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary. Our Lady is a spiritual mother to us, just as religious sisters and godmothers are, but she does so in the fullest capacity possible. This is why she is our heavenly mother, she lives in Heaven with Christ Her Son and cares for all of us as a spiritual mother in the deepest ways possible. This is possible for her in a way unlike any other person because Mary is the Mother of God. Jesus Himself is both fully God and fully man, and since Mary is the Mother of Jesus, that means she is also the Mother of God. Jesus Himself gave Mary to us from the Cross to be our mother:

When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple there whom he loved, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son. Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother." And from that hour the disciple took her into his home. ~ John 19: 26-2

Christ is not only speaking to St. John in this passage; since we ourselves are also beloved disciples of Christ, Jesus is speaking to us as well. Christ gives us Mary to be our mother, so each of us as disciples of Jesus receives the call from our crucified Lord to take Mary into the homes of our hearts. When we take Mary into the home of our heart, she knits within us the one pure desire that each of our hearts, knowingly or unknowingly, is truly longing for: Mary, in the gift of her Divine Motherhood, seeks to nurture within us the desire to come to know, love, and serve her Divine Son, Jesus.

On this Mother's Day, may we remember and keep in prayer all mothers: earthly, spiritual, and heavenly.

We truly honor the gift of motherhood and thank all mothers from the depths of our hearts for your great love for us!

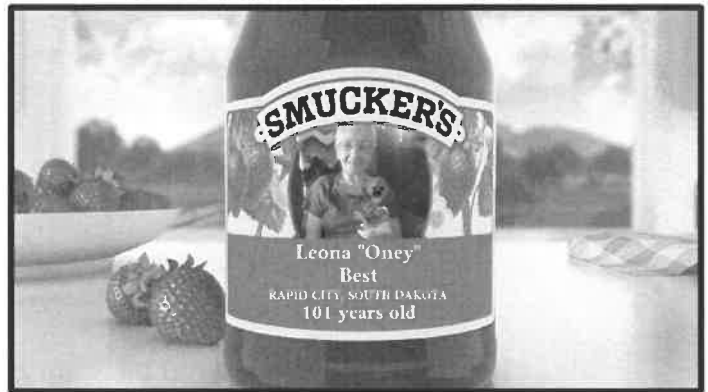
