# = Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends.

The close of the church year brings these beautiful readings of the coming of the Lord. Soon we will begin Advent again, preparing for the birth of Jesus. The Church also anticipates in Advent and the close of the Church year, the coming of Christ again in glory, a time of fulfillment and the general judgement. "Lo, the day is coming, blazing like an oven, when all the proud and all evildoers will be stubble, and the day that is coming will set them on fire, leaving them neither root nor branch, says the LORD of hosts. But for you who fear my name, there will arise the sun of justice with its healing rays." Malachi 3. 19-20 This prophecy before the birth of Jesus foretold a new dispensation, a time of unparalleled revelation, the glory of Israel, Jesus Christ. As with all of God's living word, it remains powerful today reminding us that the kingdom is not static but reaching for its zenith in the preaching of the kingdom, the love of God in Christ Jesus.

We are reminded too, of the Lord's promise to return to judge the world in the general judgement. "Before all this happens, however, they will seize and persecute you, they will hand you over to the synagogues and to prisons, and they will have you led before kings and governors because of my name. It will lead to your giving testimony." Luke 21.12-13 Connie says, "These readings are not here to scare us, but to prepare us." Well said. The Church believes that a person faces the particular judgment at death. God judges our souls and finds us either able to enter heaven immediately, needing to go through further purification in purgatory or capable of hell because of our refusal to detach ourselves from sin and our unwillingness to repent. At the end of time, there will be a general judgment, at which time our bodies will be resurrected to join our souls in our eternal life, whether that be in heaven or hell

What happens to us after death is an indication of our own personal, free choice to choose God and the path to holiness or to turn against Him. What happens after death also indicates who our God is-a God of both justice and mercy. Therefore, let us not fear death, but rather ready ourselves for it, by growing in holiness and striving for eternal life.






