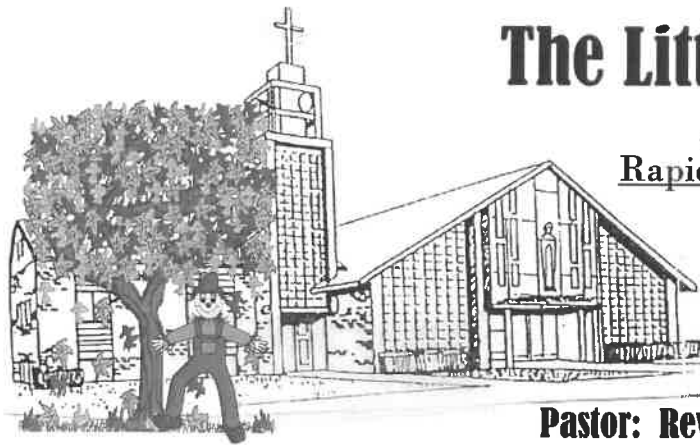

## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

This weekend is the **Annual Diocesan Appeal** for the year; it is the once yearly event that gathers the support of all the faithful to assist the work of Bishop Peter throughout western South Dakota. I have been a priest of the Diocese for 37 years and have been stationed, or lived, in all four corners of the diocese. Over the years I have been in leadership positions, and I am currently a member of the College of Consultors, Presbyteral Council, and Vicar of Clergy. I have pastored in Rapid City and on the plains. I have helped form seminarians in summer assignments and I have a special responsibility for our retired priests. From this perspective, I would like to share with you why I support the **ADA**.

1. I want to be a part of the whole mission of our diocese. My faith tells me that I am united with all my brothers and sisters in my parish, my diocese, and the worldwide Catholic Church. I have seen the impact that Terra Sancta has had as a welcoming place for parishes near and far through the hosting of VSI, Totus Tuus summer camps, family reunions, youth rallies, Pastoral Ministry days, and retreats for men and women.
2. I see firsthand how the Diocese educates and forms our young men and women for vocations to serve the Church and how the diocesan efforts have born fruit in bringing a new religious order for women to our diocese. The Diocese helped secure housing and brought groups and individuals together to start this new charism for our Diocese and schools.
3. From 1973 to the present, I have seen the way the Diocese improved the lot of the priest, who had no retirement plan or the means to save for themselves, to now providing health insurance and a pension. This could not have been accomplished by individual parishes.
4. I have depended on the ministry of the Marriage Tribunal to help me bring divorced Catholics back to the Church. I have also benefitted from the diocesan programs designed to prepare young people for marriage through retreats and couple to couple ministry.
5. I appreciate the way our diocese has stewarded the dollars that are given to the ADA, and the transparency that lay leadership helps facilitate through the Finance Council and Pastoral Council.

There are many other reasons I give as well, stemming from my own blessings and ability to give, but these are a few. Though my unique perspective and experience have given me many reasons, we should only need one or a few. Let us help provide the material gift to help our Diocese thrive. And let us meet one another in mission throughout the Diocese of Rapid City in the Eucharist.

## A letter from the Bishop...

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our diocese will soon take up the national collection for the Campaign for Human Development (CCHD). Your support for this

collection brings change to people across the country and empowers those living in poverty to transform their communities into reflections of the Kingdom of God. In addition to making a national impact, we empower those living in poverty in our own diocese, because 25% of the funds we collect stay here.

Through CCHD, generous grants have been made to grassroots corporations on American Indian reservations in western South Dakota to help build up small communities in the areas of housing, small business development, business loans, increasing financial literacy and youth entrepreneurship. The Catholic Campaign for Human Development assists with many other grassroots programs like these which are making a real difference to communities across the country.

Another example of ministry supported by CCHD donations is a group in Missouri called the Rural Community Workers Alliance (RCWWA). This agency helps essential workers in meat processing and animal feeding operations by advocating on their behalf for safe working conditions, just wages and fair treatment from employers. During the COVID-19 pandemic the group helped prompt companies to provide protective equipment and comply with health and safety guidelines.
