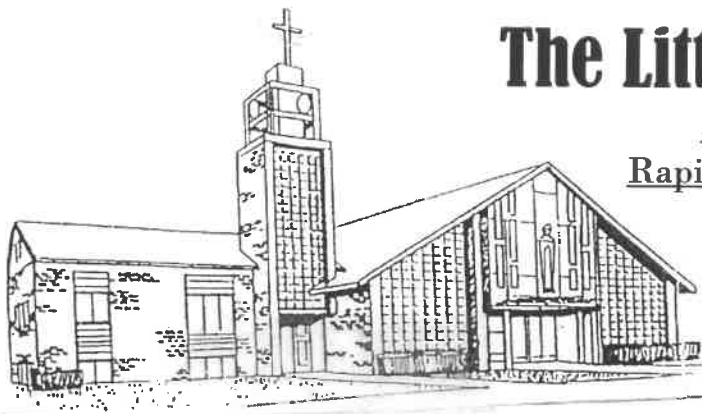

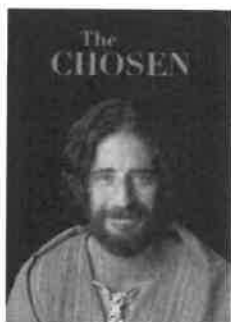

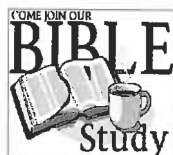

Dear Parish Family,

Since the resumption of public masses during Covid crisis, we have been offering two masses on Saturday to accommodate social distancing. We will continue to social distance with the use of the overflow seating in the social hall, but I, as pastor and sole priest, must go back to one Mass on Saturday. Priests are encouraged to have schedules that limit them to three masses on a weekend, not including weddings or funerals. I have not had a schedule with fewer than four masses since 2006. I am happy to do four masses regularly, but it is very difficult to find someone to replace me even for four masses. **(We will continue the MASK REQUIRED MASS on Fridays at Noon.)**

After consultation with parishioners who have responded in emails, and personal conversations, with me and parish staff, I have decided to have one mass on Saturday at 4:30 p.m., with confessions from 3-4:00 p.m. and after Saturday Mass. Sentiment for an earlier Mass trended about 4 to 1 over the 5 or 5:30 option. We will begin this schedule on the first Sunday of Advent, with the mass of anticipation on Saturday, November 28.

Our regular Saturday music ministers are making the greatest sacrifice for this schedule change. They come early for practice and warm up for the liturgy, curtailing some work and leisure activities for the sake of the Church community. I want to thank them for this sacrifice. We should also be aware that we cannot ask them to be here every weekend for they too have places to go and friends and family to be met. We will do our best to have music leadership available. But be aware that your voice is still the most important element of worship.

Thank you to everyone who responded with your preference. And thank you for your understanding.
