Faithful Citizenship The Lakota also have sacred places where they gathered to have ceremonies and to pray for good health and life for the people in the coming new year. Many of these places were in the Sacred Paha Sapa (Black Hills). Many of the sites correlated with the constellations in the Black Hills. For example, Black Elk Peak is associated with the Pleiades group or the "seven little girls" (wicincala sakowin) whose spirits were placed in the skies to form a constellation. Each year when the sun moved into that constellation, the people understood this as "sacred speech" directing them to go to Black Elk Peak to conduct sacred ceremonies (Lakota Star Knowledge, 1992, Sinte Gleska University). Black Elk Peak or Hinhan Kaga, (The Making of Owls) is also the place where Nicholas Black Elk received his great vision.


