## == *Fr. Francis's File* ==

*Oh come, oh come, Emmanuel! (The general cry of Advent)  
This cry needs to be heard everywhere in the world  
because we can do nothing without Him.*

My dear friends, the season of Advent is at hand! I would like to welcome and introduce you to this great season of Advent Liturgical year A 2022.

We thank the Almighty God who prepared the Universe with the changing of times and seasons. This helps us to know how God renews us and His church. This is a period I most fear!! Because Jesus may catch me unprepared!

The word Advent originates from a Latin word *Adventus* meaning COMING. This is a period where we expect the coming of Jesus in two ways: His second coming and His birth. This calls us to make good preparations for both body and spiritual matters. Throughout the season of Advent, we shall observe new changes, but each with significance.

The Liturgical color is purple which signifies hope. (Keep hoping my dear friends, hope is the gift that keeps us going forward. Never lose hope, the last thing to lose in life is hope). We are hoping for the second coming and the birth of our Savior.

Another change is refraining from the Gloria. We shall go back to it on Christmas, signifying the joy for the birth of the Savior.

The third important thing to observe is the Advent wreath bearing four candles for the four Weeks of Advent with different colors. The first purple candle represents the virtue of hope. It represents the expectation felt in anticipation of the coming Messiah. The second purple candle represents faith. It is called the "Bethlehem Candle" as a reminder of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem. The pink candle for the third Week "Gaudete Sunday" represents the virtue of joy. It is meant to remind us of the joy that the world experienced at the birth of Jesus, as well as the joy that the faithful have reached the midpoint of Advent. On the fourth week of Advent, we light the final purple candle to mark the final week of prayer and penance as we wait for the birth of our Savior. This candle symbolizes peace. It reminds us of the message of the angels "Peace on Earth, goodwill toward men." A white candle is placed in the middle of the wreath and lit on Christmas Eve. This candle is called the "Christ Candle" and represents the life of Christ. The color white is for purity—because Christ is our sinless, pure Savior.

May our guardian angels accompany us through this season. "Stand on guard our enemy the devil is prowling around like a hungry lion looking for someone to devour!"

I wish you God's blessings throughout the Advent,

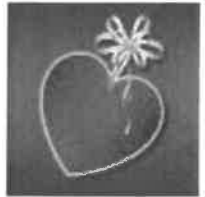
