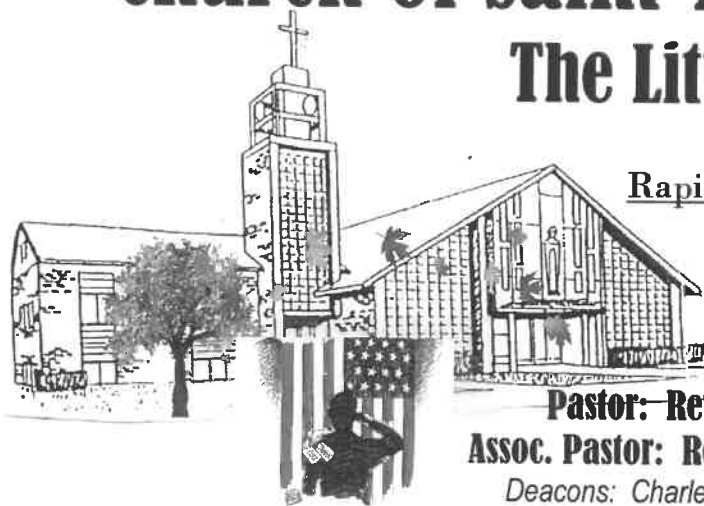

Dear Friends,

Below I have put a prayer for you to use when visiting a cemetery or praying for our deceased friends and relatives. During this month of November let us pray for them and the holy souls in Purgatory. Jesus spoke to the dead and raised them to life, Lazarus and Tabitha. It is a good thing to do, and charitable, to pray for the dead. It honors our relationship with them which has "changed, not ended," as we acknowledge in our funeral rites.

Likewise, we pray to the saints, for we will always be in communion with them. St. Cyprian of Carthage, a church father, wrote, "Let us remember one another in concord and unanimity. Let us on both sides [of death] always pray for one another. Let us relieve burdens and afflictions by mutual love, that if one of us, by the swiftness of divine condescension, shall go hence first, our love may continue in the presence of the Lord, and our prayers for our brethren and sisters not cease in the presence of the Father's mercy".

God our Father,
Your power brings us to birth,
Your providence guides our lives,

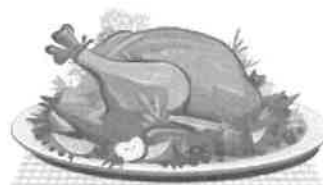

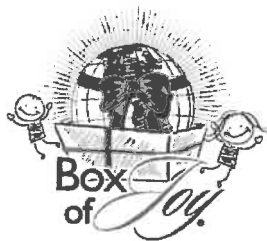
