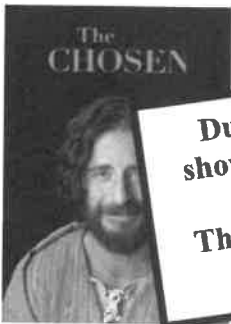

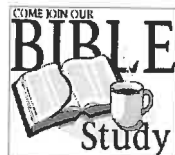

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

One of my responsibilities as a pastor is make sure the sacraments are readily accessible and reverently celebrated in the parishes. In response to this necessity we added a second mass at St. Therese on Saturday. The 4 and 5:30 masses have been well attended with our music ministry at the 5:30 mass and acapella singing at 4 pm. The five-mass weekend schedule has been difficult for me to keep up over the months, but I had always intended to begin the new Church year this Advent with a one Saturday night mass schedule.

We have the capacity to combine the masses, according to current attendance, into one Mass with the use of overflow seating and our social distancing guidelines. I have also observed that the 4 pm mass enjoys the most support of attendance by a significant margin. The 5:30 mass has an advantage of people willing to take part in liturgical ministries that make the liturgical celebration vital. While we still do not have a handle on the covid-19 infection numbers in town, we have experience and practices that ameliorate the danger.

I would suggest the following for the new schedule going forward. Saturday confessions would be 3-4 with Mass at 4:30. Our parish, among those in Rapid City, has a much higher number of senior members who prefer to have a Mass that gets them home before dark when possible. The other option would be to have confessions at 4-5, with Mass at 5:30. This option might help people on a Saturday work schedule get to mass after work. The Saturday mass originally began as a mass for workers who could not worship on Sunday morning. Of course, we also have a 5:30 evening mass which has been well attended.

I would ask you to weigh in on these two choices and let us know what you think. Please email me at kprendiville@diorc.org or stherese@diorc.org.

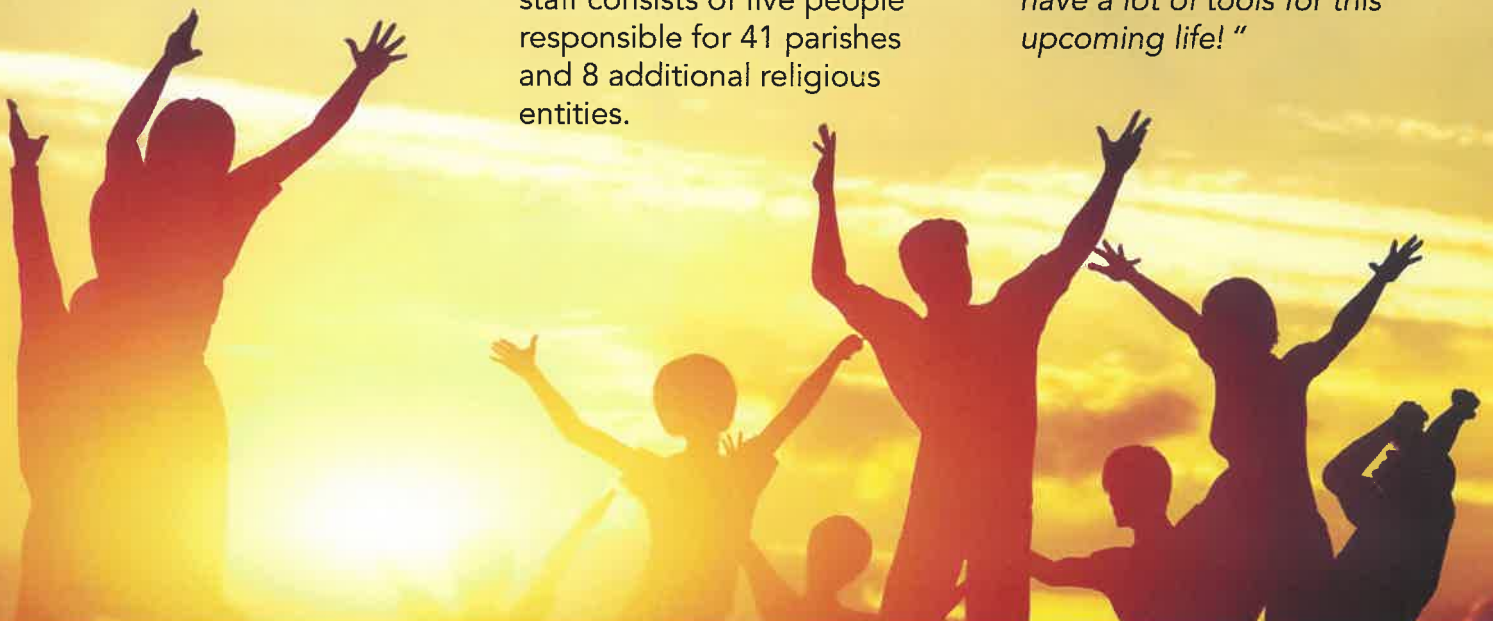
