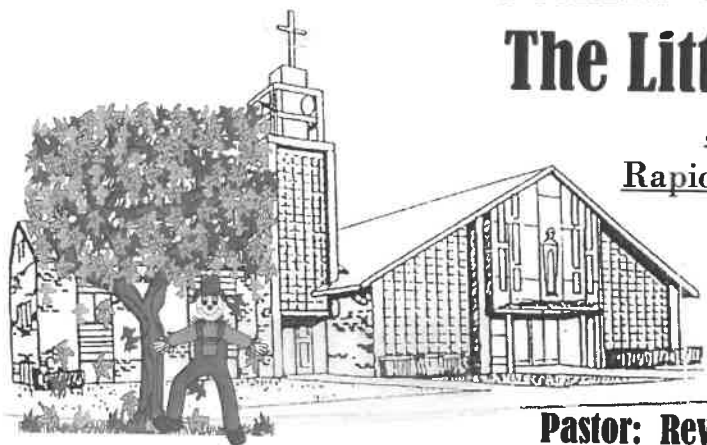

Dear Parish Family,

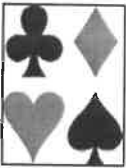

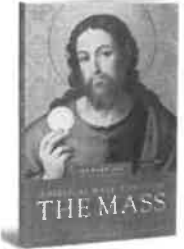
