Faithful Citizenship "All of you are very important in the life of your parish community. I don't think most Catholics realize just how much they are needed. You are not just another parish member but an integral part of the body of Christ. Do you know just how crucial you are? At the very heart of the Year of Faith and the New Evangelization is helping others to answer their call to discipleship in the service of God and his church. "Each of us -- clergy, religious, lay person; married, single; adult, child -- has a personal vocation. God intends each one of us to play a unique role in carrying out his divine plan. The challenge then, is to understand our role -- our vocation -- and to respond generously to this call from God. Christian vocation entails the practice of Stewardship." ... Stewardship is about receiving all of God's gifts (time, talent, and treasure) gratefully, cultivating them responsibly, sharing them lovingly in justice with others, and then, returning them with increase to the Lord. ... "Wherever your treasure is, there your heart will be" (Luke 12:34). ... In the end, we will be judged, not by how much we have accomplished or how much we have accumulated; not by how famous or important we have become; but by how faithful to Christ we were in putting our faith into action."
