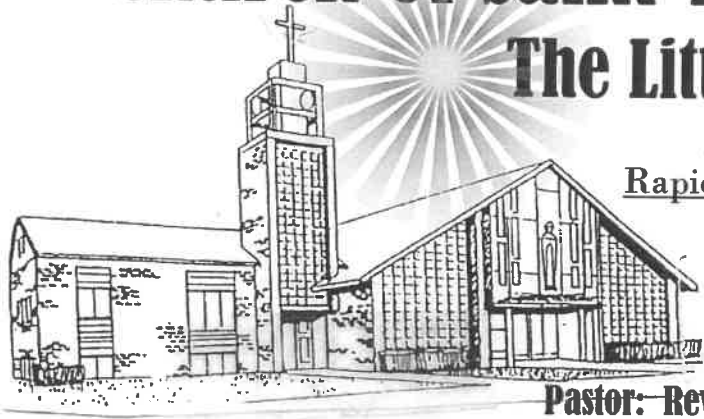

## SOUTH DAKOTA'S EXTREME ABORTION AMENDMENT

In his apostolic exhortation *Evangelii Gaudium*, Pope Francis warns us about political efforts that threaten the lives of preborn children: "Among the vulnerable for whom the Church wishes to care with particular love and concern are unborn children, the most defenseless and innocent among us. Nowadays efforts are made to deny them their human dignity and to do with them whatever one pleases, taking their lives and passing laws preventing anyone from standing in the way of this." (Par. 213) We have a responsibility, as a community that cherishes all human life, to become informed on this proposal that threatens the lives of South Dakota's preborn children, and to educate our fellow citizens. Stay tuned for further information about the abortion amendment.
