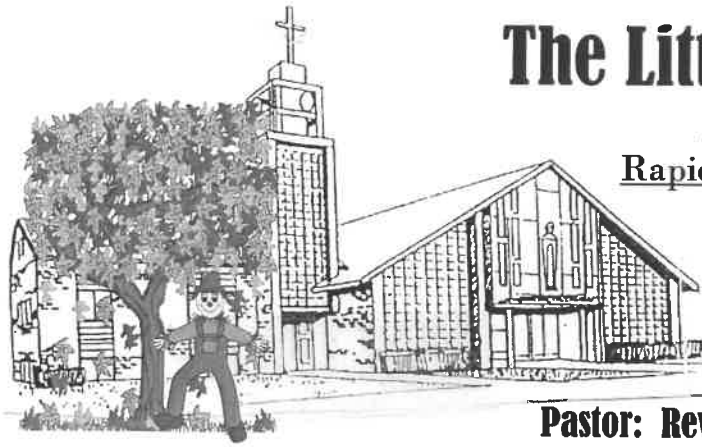

In 1926 Pope Pius XI instituted **Mission Sunday** for the whole Church with the first worldwide Mission Sunday collection taking place in October 1927. The Mission Sunday collection is always taken on a Sunday during the month of October. That day is celebrated in all the local Churches as the feast of catholicity and universal solidarity so Christians the world over will recognize their common responsibility for the evangelization of the world.

In a world where so much divides us, World Mission Sunday rejoices in our unity as missionaries by our Baptism, as it offers each one of us an opportunity to support the life-giving presence of the Church among the poor and marginalized in more than 1,111 mission dioceses.

Last week Nigeria made the news when three more seminarians were abducted by armed revolutionaries. This is a common occurrence now. Yet the Church under persecution is doing very well for vocations. This month the Diocese was joined by Fr. Collins Igwelo, a diocesan priest from Nigeria. He is one of many priests who work in Europe and the Americas to help serve and re-evangelize the Church that evangelized them.

Next week there will be a special second collection for World Mission Sunday, our gift to the missions. Let us plan to be generous and make a loving sacrifice.

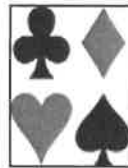

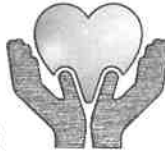
