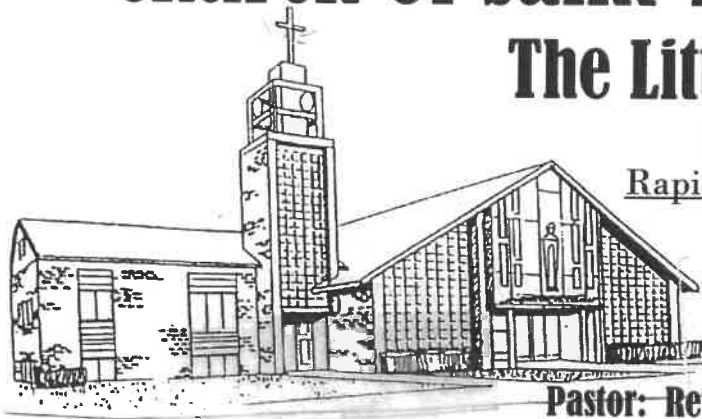

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Parish Family,

Fr. Michael and I had a wonderful retreat last week at Terra Sancta. It truly is a beautiful place to go away and rest for a while. You can always go there and do the Stations of the Cross outdoors or go in to make a visit to one of the several chapels. There will be a Vita Christi retreat October 27-29, which I highly recommend. It is put on by the Servants of the Pierced Hearts of Jesus and Mary along with Fr. Mark McCormick.

On November 1, we have the Holy Day, All Saints, and its attendant memorial, All Souls. They serve to remind us that our true home is in heaven and heaven is the goal of every Christian. Jesus said, "I have prepared a place for you, so that where I am you also may be." John 14.2 Jesus, of course, is very serious about this! If we allow the Son of God to have reign in our hearts through his Word, we should have an immense confidence in God's desire to save us and have us with him. I still hear people saying, "I just hope to make it to Purgatory by the skin of my teeth." I tell them to set their sights, and their hopes, a bit higher.

St. Therese said to one of the sisters in her convent that was afraid she might not make it to Purgatory, "You do not have enough trust. You have too much fear before the good God. I can assure you that He is grieved over this. You should not fear Purgatory because of the suffering there but should instead ask that you not deserve to go there in order to please God, Who so reluctantly imposes this punishment. As soon as you try to please Him in everything and have an unshakable trust, He purifies you every moment in His love and He lets no sin remain. And then you can be sure that you will not have to go to Purgatory." We are meant for heaven. God is merciful and just. Should we be in purgatory, our holy soul will be cheered by the knowledge that we are in God's hands who created us from dust to live and be with him!

Pray to become a saint. Pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. Give thanks to God for the great cloud of witnesses, the Saints in heaven, who surround us with their prayers.
