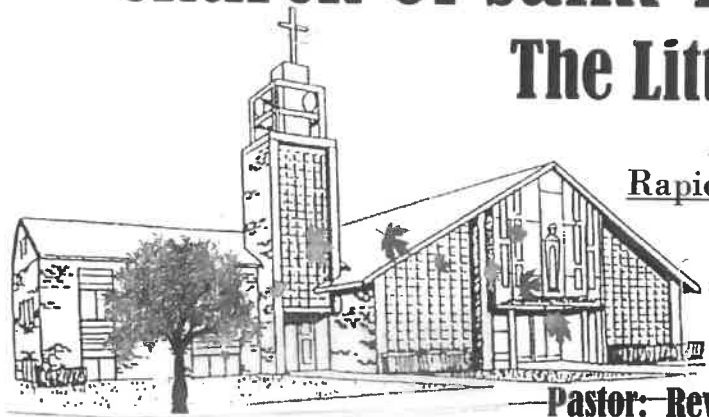

## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

This Lord's Day we have the collection for World Mission Sunday. Last week Bishop Muhich's letter gave a heartfelt plea for all of us to sacrifice and give for the international growth of the Church, and the support of our missionaries. One of the areas we help is Africa. For the last fifteen years we have had missionaries come to our diocese, Priests from Uganda and Nigeria, and religious sisters from Nigeria who demonstrate that they are as generous to us as we have been to them. Our diocese helps the diocese of Kiyinda-Mityana educate several seminarians each year and we, in return, have the help of Frs. Francis and Leonard.

I would ask you to pray with your family and ask your children what they are willing to give up, or do extra, to help the missions. Prepare with them to make a sacrificial gift from your whole family. Remember that in Lent we will have the Rice Bowls to help teach the children about the material needs of the poor worldwide.

I was speaking with Fr. Francis last Tuesday about the news story coming out of Uganda about the Ebola virus. There have been over 60 reported cases and 24 reported deaths. On Oct 15, Uganda's President Yoweri Museveni announced a 3-week lockdown for Mubende district, as well as neighboring Kassanda district. The Mubende district is where Fr. Francis served as priest. He asks, along with me, that we keep the people of his diocese and all of Uganda and East Africa in our prayer as they fight to end the recent outbreak of Ebola.

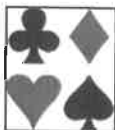

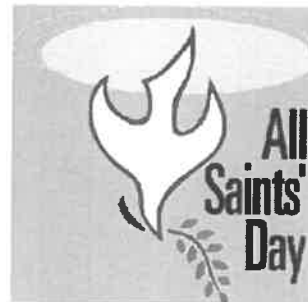

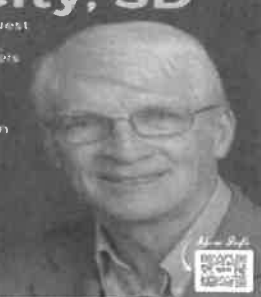
