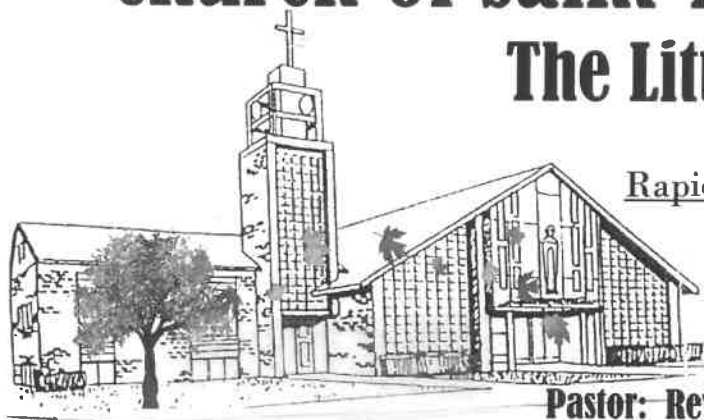

## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

Late last Saturday I arrived back from the pilgrimage to Greece and Turkey following the travels of St. Paul's missionary journeys. It was wonderful and exhausting. I will spend time in the coming months appreciating the experience of seeing the ancient ruins of cities that Paul preached to and corresponded with in the letters that became part of the New Testament. Virtually all the places were port cities for traveling by boat so he could cover distances more quickly and the commerce there insured that his message would be carried everywhere the ships' passengers traveled.

In Corinth our group had Mass in the ancient ruins, setting up on an available stone in the ruins. I remember thinking and preaching that the place at the time was about the size of Rapid City in the 80's when I was ordained, and everything that was preached was new. The preaching was just the basic facts of Christ's life and teaching. The Holy Spirit gave the gift of faith to many who were heard by Paul. We also must share our faith by

proclaiming the basic message of Christ, the kerygma, and witness to it by our love in action. Witness will always win over those who have heard teaching, words, and arguments. In Corinth Paul said, "Unless you have love you are but a clanging symbol."

This Saturday, October 1 is the memorial of St. Therese the Little Flower. She also noted that love is the vocation of any who would follow her little way, a way of radical trust in the living God.
