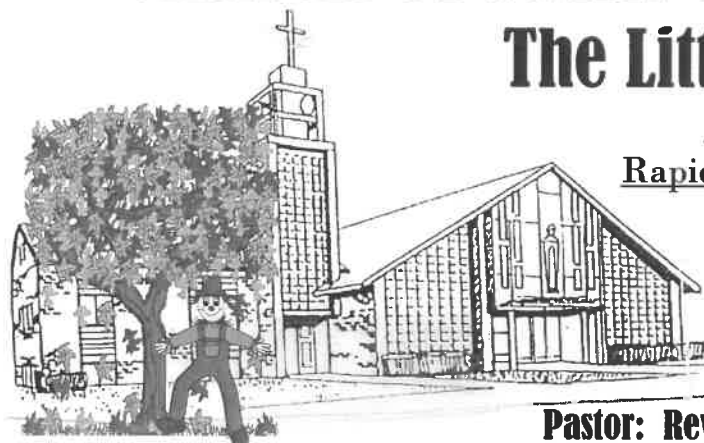

It is time to turn in my gavel and say thank you to St. Therese, to fellow council members, and to Fr. Kerry Prendiville. It has been an honor to serve you.

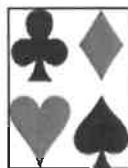
Ask yourself as a St. Therese Parishioner these questions:
