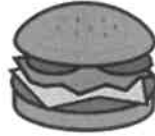

Dear Parish Family,

One of my early worries about the Covid crisis was what the shutdown of Mass would do to our mission and our budget. Many things came together to make sure that we, as a parish kept up our work in the community and were able to reach out with the Mass online. We are beginning to open up with some more activities and meetings. We have welcomed back our meeting place to parish groups and most recently we are ready to offer the series "Chosen" for viewing in the parish hall on Fridays starting October 16, at 1 p.m. and 7 p.m. for eight weeks. Fr. Mark and I binge-watched the series twice last summer. I hope you will be able to come and watch. We will have a facilitator to help us discuss the series and lead in faith sharing if you wish. I highly encourage this series!

Despite the challenges of COVID 19, St Therese parish was able to finish the fiscal year on June 30, 2020, with income over expenses by \$19,116.71. The generosity of our parishioners is evident when you see that collections remained strong at a time when parishes across the country struggled to maintain normalcy. We were able to decrease spending in many areas - some by choice and some directly due to the pandemic restrictions. As a result of updating the lighting last year, electric utility costs were approximately \$3,500 lower than the previous year. Sincere thanks go to each and every one of you. Jesus shows His love through people like you!

Our feast day is October 1. We celebrated with the Mass in the morning. I would like to leave you with these words from our Holy Patron: "If I did not simply live from one moment to another, it would be impossible for me to be patient, but I only look at the present, I forget the past, and I take good care not to forestall the future."

St. Therese, the Little Flower, pray for us!



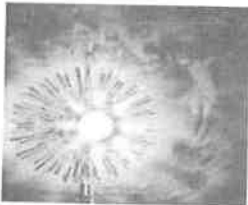

~ The 2020 "St. Therese Catholic Church Sidewalk Repair" Eagle Scout project work was completed in July. The sidewalk along Dilger Avenue leading to Van Buren Street was widened to allow for easier grounds maintenance and to provide a wider walkway to users.

~ The 2019 Eagle Scout Project "Retiring Old Glory" – the Flag retirement drop box – has retired over 1,000 United States and South Dakota flags to date. Troop 7 Scouts and Adults have turned in 900+ nylon and synthetic flags to local Veterans Service agencies and will be personally retiring cotton and natural fiber flags on September 26 as described in United States Flag Code.

~ Troop 7 was selected as one of the "Golden Stave" winners at the Annual Pilgrimage ceremony on September 12, 2020. Four golden staves are presented to the units with the most impressive overall program for the current Scouting year (September to September). In 2020, Scouts from Troop 7 recorded 48 nights of camping, 132 Frost Points, 348 hours of community service, almost 285 hiking miles (total, not all at once), filled 19 positions at local Black Hills Area Council events and advanced 60% of the total scouts by at least one rank.

~ Troop 7 was selected to receive the Order of the Arrow Unit of Excellence award for 2020 which is reserved for units invite the lodge to conduct quality unit elections, participate in lodge events and operate a complete OA Unit\_Rep program. The Order of the Arrow is Scouting's National Honor Society. Three new Scout OA candidates were elected by Troop 7 in 2020.
