Faithful Citizenship *In his encyclical, **Laborem Exercens (On Human Work)**, Pope John Paul II sets forth the ethical statement that there is a "priority of labor over capital."* Pope John Paul II views human work as an essential part of a person's dignity and vocation. 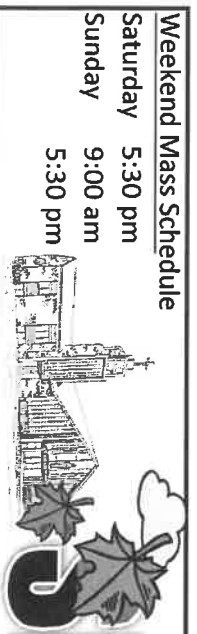

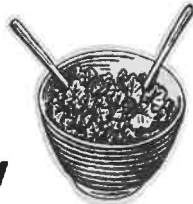


