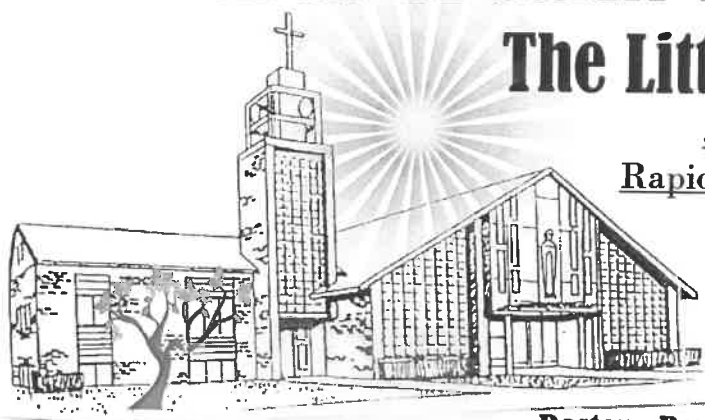

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

In Church life there are Ministries where we serve the needs of others: education, poverty assistance, service projects, delivering meals, or homeless shelters. There are also "in house" ministries which primarily serve the Liturgy. Most people in the Church, active in the liturgy should be able to find one of these ministerial roles to fill.

Music ministry perhaps represents talents that are more specialized: musicians, cantors, proclaimers of the word, extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist, Usher/Greeters.

Proclaimers of the Word, lectors, must have a love of scripture and value its sovereignty in God revealing himself to his people. They must prepare by first understanding the Word and proclaim it articulately. While a natural gift for reading helps, sincerity and preparation are most important. We can currently use more lectors in both our parishes.

Extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist should know and love the Lord in his sacramental presence. They nurture an awe of God in adoration and prayer. They recognize the awesomeness of the Lord and remember they are giving the Precious Body and Blood of the Lord. This gift makes them special, but they are extraordinary because a bishop, priest, or deacon ordinarily ministers the Eucharist. Should a priest show up, they may be asked to humbly relinquish their ministry that day. Having received the Eucharist, they become what they receive, and thus, may wish to bring the Eucharist to the homebound or hospitalized. They bring Christ himself in friendship and companionship when they take the Eucharist to those who cannot attend Church.

Ushers/Greeters are the face of welcome and service to everyone coming to the Liturgy. They see that people know where they may find restrooms, take their agitated child, and make sure people are seated by helping them find room. They frequently receive the gifts of the community and safeguard the collection. They are patient and willing to overcome shyness so others will be comfortable. Because there are more introverts in the world than extroverts, we need both kinds of people in this ministry. If you have a heart for hospitality, or know that you should, we can really use you.

Please give these ministries a prayerful consideration. You can give yourself once a month to service at the Mass you attend, or trade your turn with another when you need flexibility.

Next week, Service at the Altar. You can have wrinkles and be an altar server!

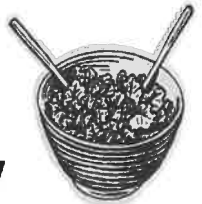
