== *Fr. Kerry's Korner* ==

This is a letter that went out in the mail.

You may have received it already, or it is on the way.

Dear Friends,

We are living in challenging times. Some of our leaders are teaching us to not trust any governmental agency, but to trust only in a personality. We must search for facts and separate them from opinion from news sources. We have political organizers encouraging us to avoid cooperation or compromise in moving forward as a people. And for good measure we are dealing with a pandemic that treats the weak and elderly differently than the young and healthy. Bad feelings can be generated by fear or different beliefs on the subject. Therefore, I and the people I consult, our Councils, staff and diocesan leaders have been discerning the way forward in worship and gathering as part of our Church life. As always St. Paul has good words for us in this Sunday's reading: *Brothers and sisters: Owe nothing to anyone, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. Romans 13.8*

Beginning in September we will see some easing of restrictions for the liturgy. Our protocols have been somewhat more strict than other parishes because our parish is different. We have a much higher percentage of elderly members than either Cathedral, Blessed Sacrament, and OLBH.

1~September 14 we will begin daily masses Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday at St. Therese at 7:30 a.m. This will allow me to better attend meetings, do funerals, etc. Mass at St. John's will continue at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday at the Church.

2~September 18 we will begin an additional Mass at Noon on Fridays at St. Therese exclusively for those who need and want to have an environment where all are masked. This is not a mass of your convenience. It is set up only for those who intend to mask. While we do not have the Sunday obligation, I recommend this Mass as a way for those who cannot come on weekends to attend. **NO MASK, NO MASS.**

3~September 19 & 20 we will allow more attendance by seating in every other pew. This will bring us into line with practice in other parishes. Please continue to call before Friday at 3 for a seating assignment. This weekend we will also bless our catechists and families who are the first teachers of their children in the way of faith on Catechetical Sunday. There will be no change in practice at St. John's, New Underwood.

4~October 2 & 3 we will end the giving of seating assignments for weekend masses. We will ask you to do your best to socially distance as family groups and singles. We have ample room in the social hall downstairs on

closed circuit tv. Because we are moving to this practice, to give everyone a good option for greater social distancing and more caution, we will have in place the Friday Noon Mass (see above).

These changes are a measured step rooted in caution and informed by our past practice. Because we remain in a fluid situation, we may have to change our plans at some given time in the future. Your staff began back in March to operate under the saying, Be Safe, Be Kind. These are good words. Whether a response to the confusing COVID crisis, or the free for all of the election season, be safe and be kind. You will never regret treating others with forbearance and respect. I am reminded of the lines from Gabriel García Márquez's book Love in the Time of Cholera, "He was still too young to know that the heart's memory eliminates the bad and magnifies the good, and that thanks to this artifice we manage to endure the burden of the past."
